Vehicle On Display

1. The vehicle must meet the All British Day Eligibility Criteria.
2. A vehicle entered for display shall also comply with the following requirements;
 - A. Shall not be offered '**For Sale**' or bear any sign, poster, banner or the like that indicates that the vehicle is '**For Sale**'.
 - B. Shall not display any sign, poster, banner or the like that advertises any business or service.
 - C. Shall not display any sign, poster, banner or the like that advertises a charity other than the charity/charities sponsored by All British Day – Brisbane.
 - D. Shall not display any sign, poster, banner or the like that promotes a sponsor of the display vehicle nor may any sign, poster, banner or the like, promoting a sponsor of a particular vehicle or vehicles, be erected in the area allocated to that vehicle, marque or club.
 - E. Shall not be offered by the owner/driver, any vehicle part or merchandise or the like for sale, swap or '*Give Away*'.
3. The following exceptions to the above rules shall apply;
 - A. 2B, small labels, that are affixed to windscreen or windows, relating to vehicle servicing or maintenance or dealerships where vehicles are purchased or serviced or the like are acceptable.
 - B. 2D, any sticker, label, transfer or the like promoting a sponsor, that is permanently attached to a competition type vehicle shall be acceptable.
 - C. Any sticker, label, transfer or the like that promotes membership of a motoring type club or organisation shall be acceptable.
 - D. A commercial vehicle bearing the name and or logo of a business either past or present which is part of that vehicles configuration is acceptable.
 - E. Any logo/s depicting a vehicles manufacturer and or builder shall be acceptable.
4. Vehicle owners shall not display or otherwise locate any vehicle or part of a vehicle or any other object relating to the vehicle, marque or club outside of the allocated area for that vehicle, marque or club.
5. Vehicles displayed as part of a '*Trade Stand*' shall not be considered for judging in any category unless an entry fee for '*A Vehicle On Display*' has been paid in addition to the fee for a Trade Stand.

6. The owner and/or driver of a vehicle who intends to enter their vehicle for judging in a category must display the '**Entrant Information**' card, provided in their '*Official Programme*' pack, on their windscreen or other visible position on their vehicle to be eligible for judging in the event.
7. The award of a trophy in each category shall be subject to the following conditions:
 - A. Three vehicles, in each category, will be selected by the judge/s of that category.
 - B. A vehicle selected as the winner in its category must be present during the awards ceremony to receive the trophy.
 - C. A vehicle, that has been selected by the judge/s, that has left the event prior to the award ceremony will forfeit its position.
 - D. The trophy will be awarded to the next vehicle, selected by the judge/s in that category, that is present at the time of the awards.
 - E. Should all of the selected vehicles, in a category, leave the event prior to the awards the organisers reserve the right to either select a further vehicle from the category or not award the trophy in that year.
